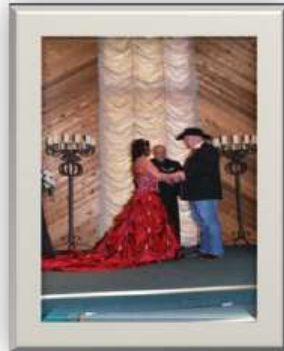

Hello members,

May 12, 2011

It has been brought to my attention that some of us have become very relaxed on a State Law which requires us to check and show proof of a negative Coggins for horses brought to our arenas. I have been informed of a false alarm that a horse in our Association tested positive to a yearly check up Coggins screening. The original test showed positive. State law requires the TX Animal Health Commission to be notified of all positive results. Protocol was followed and a second test was performed by the TX Animal Health Commission. The second test confirmed the horse has a negative Coggins and has not been infected.

We cannot change the past, so from here on I ask that each of you please be sure to have Coggins papers checked at any function you host. It is my responsibility to make sure Coggins papers are checked at N.A.R.C.&S.P. hosted functions ,so please help spread the word that without your negative Coggins papers we legally cannot let you on the grounds .

Equine Infectious Anemia, commonly called Swamp Fever, is an infectious virus transmitted by flies. It can be fatal, but, if the horse survives, the horse will remain a carrier of EIA for the rest of its life. There is no cure and currently no vaccine to prevent the disease. Thus, numerous laws and regulations have been established to prevent the spread of EIA.

State law requires that blood drawn for a Coggins test must be drawn by a licensed veterinarian who must fill in very specific forms including a drawing of identification marks and characteristics of the horse being tested. The veterinarian must send the blood sample and form to a specifically approved laboratory for testing. The test results are then written into the forms which are sent to the veterinarian. The veterinarian will then supply these forms to the horse owner for interstate and intrastate travel. The written results are important and must be kept with the horse in the event of inspection by law enforcement.
